### REGISTRATION

Thank you for your patience, we are nearly ready to release the Registration documents but are having a few teething issues with the updated system from the Redlands event this year. Hopefully this will happen well before Christmas. Early Bird discounts will be available to Saturday the 1<sup>st</sup> of February 2020 with full Registrations closing on Sunday the 22<sup>nd</sup> of March

Competitors will notice that there will be a space for those with their own Dorians (transponders) to nominate the serial number as we are enlisting the assistance of the Albury & District Motor Club for timing at the speed event. Dorians will be provided free of charge on the day for those that don't have one or forget to bring theirs along.

Thanks to Mike Herlihy, negotiations with CAMS have resulted in the Single Day Licence Fee for the Observation Run at \$25.00, significantly lower than recent years.
